Community Policy Areas

- Selection of Policy Areas
 - The Charter covers a wide range of areas
 - The Charter takes over results achieved by various regional frameworks
- Progress made by the Charter
 - Uniting various cooperation under the single framework with clear and consistent objectives



The Structure of Policy Provisions in the Charter

- Charter provisions and Common Action Plans
- Cooperation based on those Action Plans
 - Examples of subjects in Action Plans
- Action Plans must be adopted by consensus of the Member States

- Regional Security (Article II-2)
- Market Building (Article II-7)
 - “An ever closer market” will be more than ordinary free trade area
 - Example protocol on the Economic Partnership Framework Agreement
- Monetary and Financial Cooperation (Article II-8)
- Environmental Cooperation (Article II-12)
